**TX-TF2 Member's may be denied from deployment  
based upon the following criteria.**

1. Blood pressure\* - diastolic greater than 100 mm Hg and/or systolic greater than 150 mm Hg
2. Pulse\* - > 70% maximum heart rate (220-age)
3. Respiratory rate - > 24 per minute
4. Temperature - > 99.5°F (oral) or > 100.5°F (core) or < 97.0°F (oral) or < 98.0°F (core)
5. Weight - no pre-entry exclusion
6. EKG - dysrhythmia not previously detected or not controlled by medication.
7. Skin evaluation - open sores, large area of rash or significant sunburn
8. Mental status - altered mental status (i.e., slurred speech, clumsiness, weakness)
9. Pregnant

\* Controlled by medication.

**Physical Expectations**

The Task Force member will be deploying to disaster areas as part of the Urban Search and Rescue Response. They will be capable of performing the following tasks:

1. Live in tents in an austere environment for up to 10 days in hot and cold environments.
2. Lift and move heavy objects.
3. Climb on rubble and other debris.
4. Work in contaminated environments and wear respiratory protection.
5. Work in confined space areas.
